

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## ARMADA

### Composer's Programme Notes:

Armada was written as a gift to Mark Heron and the RNCM Wind Orchestra in appreciation of their second recording project of my wind orchestra music for the MEM Recordings label. In 1588 the Spanish launched their Armada, a naval tour-de-force, against the English fleet based in Plymouth. It did not result in their favour. However, this piece has nothing to do with that historical occasion, it is purely derived from the title Armada and the 'rhythm' of that enterprise. I would describe it as an encore-outing, an opportunity for bands to display their technique and flamboyance within a three minute time restraint – perhaps not one to be taken as seriously as an invasion by a real-life Spanish Armada!

### Performance Notes:

- a) Tenuto (-) markings indicate a slight emphasis to a note, reserving the accent (>) sign for a more pronounced effect. The weight of these in this piece is relative to the indicated overall dynamic level at any given section.
- b) The overall dynamic detail (and its progress) is indicated at the top of the full score and following pages so that the conductor can steer the ensemble through the whole journey. These indications are also in the parts but it should be understood that at times they don't apply to all instruments as they may well be *tacet* on occasion or part-occasion. In the score and parts the 'start' dynamic is indicated on each instrument's start note within each section. However there are a few moments of overlap where this is followed up asap with the new 'start' dynamic. In general terms crescendo marks are included as one section flows into a new one, though players are at liberty to 'go' with the direction of lines within the set dynamic (ie crescendo upwards and diminuendo downwards unless otherwise indicated). Once the principle is understood then a reading of graded dynamics can be achieved between conductor and performers: ebb and flow, tension and relaxation are the key factors to be realised.
- c) Indications are present for single (1. or 2.) or paired instruments (a2) throughout. This is to provide some transparency, contrast in texture and to reserve greater weight for moments where it will be most effective. However, bands with greater numbers than the 'written' orchestration can play with these additional performers at the discretion of the conductor with the effect of the acoustic in question borne in mind.
- d) The Percussion parts are large (7) with only the 3<sup>rd</sup> player being given a 'station' of mixed instruments to play. They should be placed across the rear of the ensemble in a semicircle shape subject to the venue in question at the discretion of the conductor.
